Policy Title	EMERGENCY TRANSPORTATION TO VETERINARY CLINIC FOR PET OWNERS WHO RECEIVE GOVERNMENT SUBSIDIZED INCOME
Policy Number	1 – 2006
Policy Statement	This policy governs the manner in which the Foundation will provide transportation in case of an emergency to a veterinary clinic and/or hospital for pet owners who receive subsidized income.

Brant Animal Aid Foundation shall in the case of an emergency pay the cost involved in providing a taxi for the owner and pet to a veterinarian's office.

The procedure involved will be as follows:

1. It will be determined by Director Mary Welsh whether it is an emergency and the Foundation will provide for the cost of transportation.
2. Brant Taxi will be provided with the pick up details, i.e. name and address, and destination.
3. The client who will need transportation from the veterinarian's office to his/her home address can make the return call.
4. Brant Taxi will bill the Foundation once a month for such service, to
