Policy Title EMERGENCY TRANSPORTATION TO

VETERINARY CLINIC FOR PET OWNERS WHO RECEIVE GOVERNMENT SUBSIZED INCOME

Policy Number 1 – 2006

Policy Statement This policy governs the manner in which the Foundation

will provide transportation in case of an emergency to a veterinary clinic and/or hospital for pet owners who

receive subsidized income.

Brant Animal Aid Foundation shall in the case of an emergency pay the cost involved in providing a taxi for the owner and pet to a veterinarian's office.

The procedure involved will be as follows:

- 1. It will be determined by Director Mary Welsh whether it is an emergency and the Foundation will provide for the cost of transportation.
- 2. Brant Taxi will be provided with the pick up details, i.e. name and address, and destination.
- 3. The client who will need transportation from the veterinarian's office to his/her home address can make the return call.
- 4. Brant Taxi will bill the Foundation once a month for such service, to Brant Animal Aid Foundation

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
